

Named in memory of Amy Wolgin Wiener, Amy's Park is a beautiful property of ponds, marshes and forests in the uplands of Bolton Landing. It was purchased by the LGLC in February, 2012 and its hiking trails officially opened to the public on July 13, 2012.

The Bolton property includes the headwaters for Indian Brook, one of Lake George's largest tributaries, and contains important wildlife habitat within its large, unfragmented forest and wetland complexes. Protecting this fragile property prevents excess nutrients and sediments generated by development from flowing into Indian Brook and Northwest Bay.

The LGLC purchased the property for \$500,000 from a conservation buyer, who held the land until the LGLC was able to finalize the purchase. Funding for the deal was provided through two grants: a State Environmental Protection Fund grant from the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation, and a Federal North American Wetlands Conservation Act grant.

- Park only in the designated areas.
- Stay on the marked trails to avoid damage to surrounding vegetation.
- Be courteous of other preserve guests.
- **Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your dog; do not leave plastic dog waste bags on the property.**
- No unauthorized removal of plants or animals.
- Hunting is allowed at this preserve but an LGLC permit is required. Contact the LGLC for an application.
- No camping or fires.
- No motorized or non-motorized vehicles beyond the parking area.
- Please help us keep the preserve clean; take out all trash with you. Do not litter.

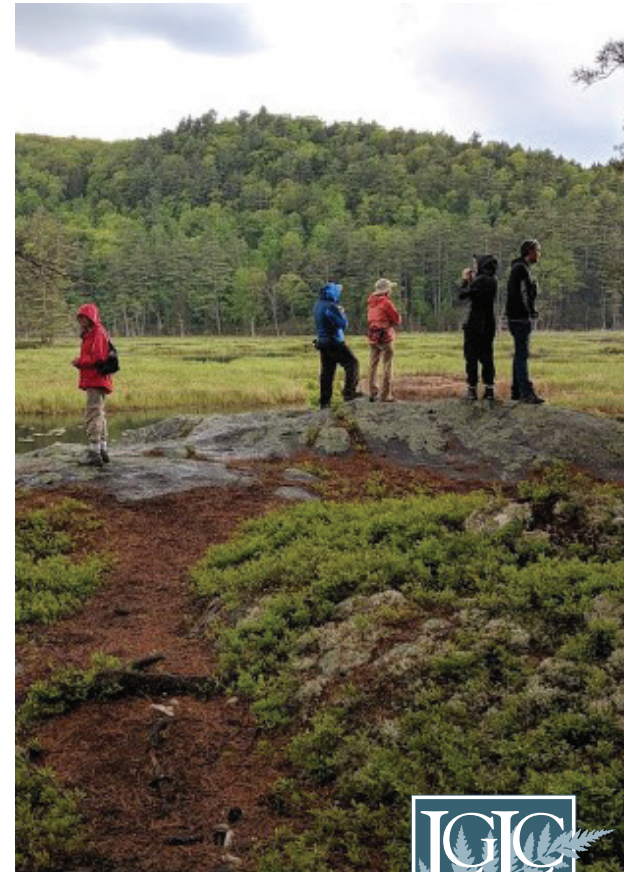
